Youth Justice Court Fellowship

Are you a team player looking for the chance to take the next step in your legal career? Are you looking to make a change in the lives of the youth in the community? If so, Queens Defenders wants you to join our team as the Youth Justice Court Fellow for our innovative Youth Justice Court Program.

The Youth Justice Court is a program in partnership with the Queens Public Library aimed at providing a restorative justice approach for youthful offenders aged 13-19 who commit low-level crimes. Youth are referred to the YJC programs where they are represented by young people under guidance of attorneys and the YJC Coordinator. The YJC Fellow will lead discussions and educate participants on legal issues.

This is a Part-Time (20 hours per week) position, however, there is an opportunity for Full Time employment for those who seek to learn more about working for a Public Criminal Defense Firm.

- Proficient legal researcher
- A resourceful and skilled facilitator that can engage and motivate people in a way that builds and fosters teamwork and collaboration.

Essential Duties/Responsibilities

- Coordinate and run multiple sessions in schools and libraries across the borough of Queens.
- Facilitate conversations, oversee data collection for each site, and ensure program materials/food are at each location in a timely manner.
- Provide direct coaching and supervision to participating youth.
- Provide legal education sessions and produce written legal information.
